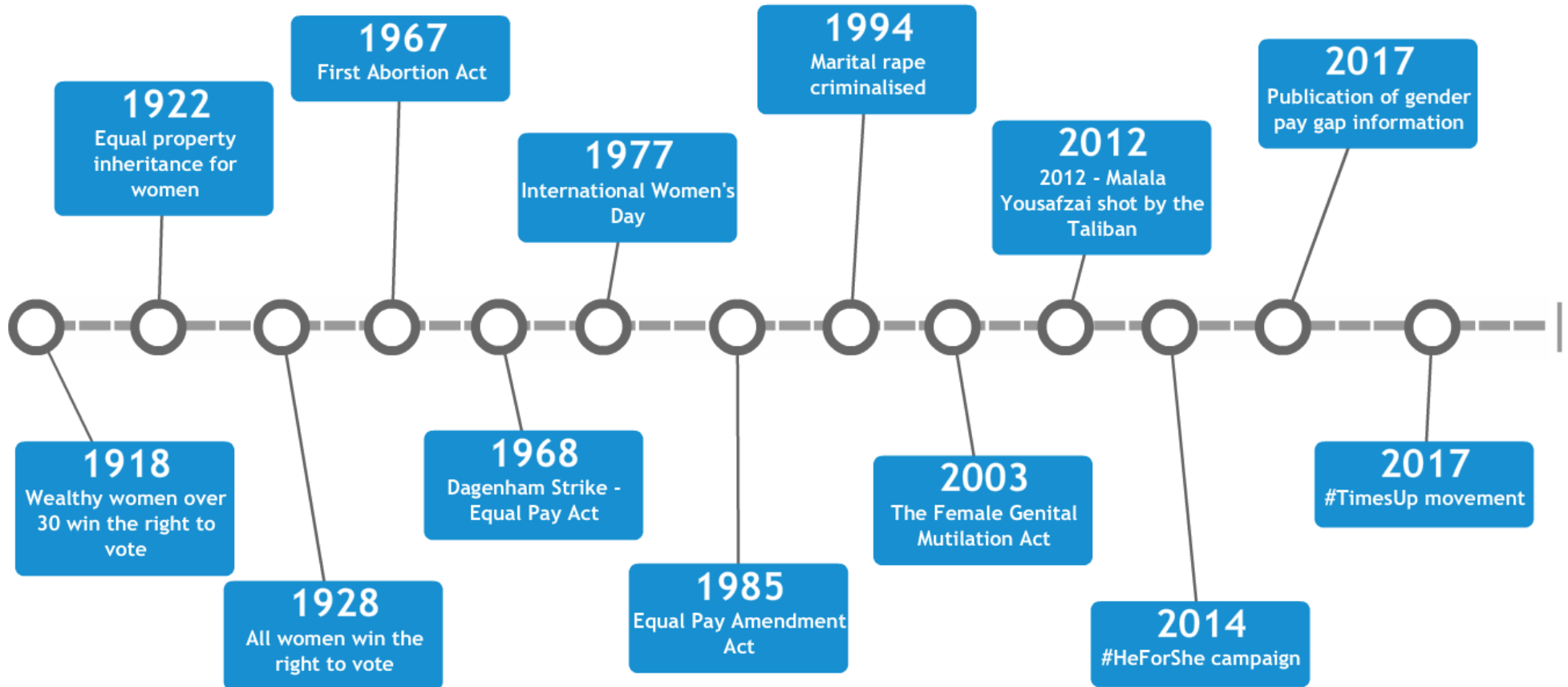

### Items:

- **1918**  
Women over the age of 30 and with a fortune over £5 (in contemporary money) are awarded the right to vote.
- **1922**  
The Law of Property Act allows both husband and wife to inherit property equally.
- **1928**  
Women are now awarded equal voting rights to men.
- **1967**  
The Abortion Law Reform Bill decriminalises abortion on particular grounds and later becomes known as the Abortion Act.
- **1968**  
The women of Dagenham's Ford factory strike and their actions lead to the Equal Pay Act.
- **1977**  
The UN General Assembly formalise International Women's Day as an annual event.
- **1985**  
The amendment to the act states that women must be paid equal to men for work of equal value.
- **1994**  
Rape within a married couple is now made a crime.
- **2003**  
The Female Genital Mutilation Act amends the 1985 Prohibition of Female Circumcision Act.
- **2012**  
Malala Yousafzai is shot on her way home from school for speaking out about girls' rights for education in Pakistan.
- **2014**  
The United Nations launches the #HeForShe campaign, fronted by Emma Watson who gave a speech prompting those who believe in equality to identify as feminists.
- **2017**  
Companies are forced to publish the earning statistics of employees according to gender.
- **2017**  
The #TimesUP campaign launches in the wake of the online #MeToo harassment campaign and widespread Hollywood abuse scandals.
